*Edinburgh five-piece Jakil have welded their wide and eclectic musical influences together to create a stunning supershiny mix of pop, rock and funk which is winning fans and turning influential heads across the country.*

*The guys were selected by BBC Radio One as Annie Mac's House Band. Their debut single "Who Are Ya?" picked up its first national radio play, and grabbed further airplay across the UK. Jakil also held the title of Radio Forth's "One To Watch" and have provided support for the likes of Wheatus, Sandi Thom, The Twang, Orange Unsigned finalists Hip Parade and Amy Studt. In the last few months, Jakil have recorded and released a new EP, and played in some of Scotland's most prestigious live music venues. Since the turn of the year, they have released another new EP via iTunes, secured radio play on stations as far afield as Aberdeen and Penzance, launched a free monthly podcast for fans, become the first unsigned band to digitally "covermount" their music in a deal with a major newspaper (The Scotsman), and headlined three major gigs across Edinburgh and Glasgow. With a forthcoming session on BBC Radio Scotland, a return support slot with Hip Parade, and a tour of North East England lined up for the end of May, the future is looking very bright indeed for Jakil*
